

Grading system

The student's knowledge will be assessed by a 100-point grading system, where points are distributed as follows:

Five types of positive evaluation:

- (A) Excellence - 91-100 points;
- (B) Very good - 81-90 points;
- (C) Good - 71-80 points;
- (D) Satisfactory-61-70points
- (E) Sufficient - 51-60 points.

Two types of negative evaluation:

- (F_x) Marginal failed - 41-50 points of the maximum assessment, which means that the student needs more work to pass and is allowed to take one additional exam with independent work;
- (F) Failed - the maximum grade is 40 points or less, which means that the work done by the student is not enough and he/she has to study the subject again.

If a student does not or fails to pass the minimum competency defined in each assessment form, he/she will be given an F grade, which will require him/her to repeat the course.

(F_x) In case of absence from the assessment and/or final exam, as well as in order to improve the received grade, the student has the right to retake the final exam once for an additional exam in the same semester, not less than 5 days after the announcement of the final exam results. The grade obtained in the additional exam is the final grade and is reflected in the final assessment of the course.
